

Moving objects


Desktop systems


To move objects just take your cursor over the element and click the left mouse button to select it.






You will see some grips in the selected object, in the example shown below there are 3 grips. Move the cursor over one of them and click the left mouse button. A context menu appears with actions you can do with the objects. Select the move option. Then you can move the object to the position you want.






Mobile devices


To move objects in your mobile device, first move your cursor over the object.




Then without releasing your first finger, tap the drawing area with another finger to select the object. You will see that some grips appear over the object (highlighted in the figure below).




Move your cursor over some the grips and without releasing this finger, tap the drawing area with another finger. You will notice that a context menu appears.



Select the move option.



Move your object to the desired position.



Then without releasing your finger, tap the drawing area with another finger to set the new object position.
